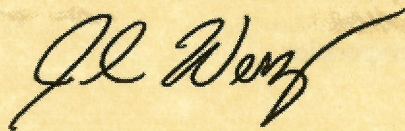

Recipe

Large Grain: Kentucky Corn; Distillers Grade #1 and #2
Small Grain: Plump Rye
Finish Grain: Distiller's Malted Barley

Cooking / Fermentation

Milling screen: #10
Cook Temperature: 240 degrees Fahrenheit
Water: Kentucky limestone with reverse osmosis
Fermentation: Stainless Steel
Mash: Sour

Distillation & Aging

Distillation: Double distilled; beer still and doubler
Proof off still: 140 proof
Barrel: New, white oak; #4 Char; charred for 55 seconds
Barrel maker: Independant Stave; Lebanon KY
Barrel entry proof: 125 proof
Barrel size: 53 liquid gallons; 66.25 Original Proof Gallons
Warehouse: Warehouses L, Q, K, and P
Floor: Floors 1, 2, and 3
Evaporation loss: 89% % of the original whiskey lost to evaporation

Bottling

Filtration: Chill
Product Age: 18 and 4 months old at bottling
Tasting comment: Nose: Opens with dark tobacco and well-worn leather, accented by ripe cherry and a lively peppery edge
Palate: Caramel's gentle sweetness woven through with supple leather and bursts of cherry brightness
Finish: Smooth yet resonant, unfolding with lasting oak, a touch of vanilla, and a gentle echo of sweetness
