**TWO W.L. WELLER BOURBONS RECEIVE DOUBLE GOLD MEDALS
AT NORTH AMERICAN BOURBON & WHISKEY COMPETITION**

Thirteen Buffalo Trace Whiskies Honored

FRANKFORT, KY (Sept. 17, 2020) – W. L. Weller Antique 107 and W.L. Weller 12 Year Old each received a Double Gold medal at the 2020 North American Bourbon & Whiskey Competition (NABWC). Eleven other Buffalo Trace whiskies were also awarded medals, including four Gold medals and seven Silver medals.

The NABWC promotes excellence in bourbon, whiskey, and moonshine through a double-blind competition and is based on a 100-point scale. The spirits are judged by styles and price categories, and this year's competition was judged virtually in light of COVID-19.
