To celebrate this milestone and the fans who have been instrumental in its growth, the distillery is offering a one-of-a-kind Buffalo Trace Distillery experience... but there is a catch.

Buffalo Trace Distillery, whose portfolio includes the 2022 Antique Collection, will also donate bourbon, in the name of the winner, to a mutually agreed upon 501(c) charity.
