E.H. TAYLOR SMALL BATCH RECEIVES DOUBLE GOLD AT 2017 SAN FRANCISCO WORLD SPIRITS COMPETITION

Judges award Buffalo Trace Distillery spirits with two Double Gold, 12 total medals

FRANKFORT, FRANKLIN COUNTY, KY (May 10, 2017) E.H. Taylor Small Batch Bourbon and William Larue Weller Bourbon each received Double Gold medals at the 17th annual San Francisco World Spirits Competition where a record-breaking 2,100 entries were submitted for a blind tasting.

The celebrated Double Gold medal is only given to the few entries that receive a Gold medal rating by all the members of the judging panel. This year, 43 of the industry's finest spirits experts reviewed each entry before ultimately awarding Buffalo Trace Distillery spirits with two Double Gold medals and a total of 12 medals.
