12 Other Buffalo Trace Spirits Receive Medals at 2019 New York World Wine & Spirits Competition

FRANKFORT, KY (Oct. 22, 2019) – Following the results of the 2019 New York World Wine & Spirits Competition (NYWSC), 14 Buffalo Trace Distillery spirits were awarded medals. Wheatley Vodka and W.L. Weller Craft Your Perfect Bourbon (C.Y.P.B.) Bourbon top the list of medals with Double Gold Best in Class Medals. Wheatley Vodka received Best Vodka and W.L. Weller C.Y.B.P. received Best Straight Bourbon.

In addition to the two Double Gold medals, the spirits produced at Buffalo Trace Distillery received 12 other medals. The brands were awarded as follows:
